Dyspraxia affects the planning of future acts, and is associated with problems of perception, language and thought. There is a lot of overlap between the signs and symptoms of dyspraxia and dyslexia. Research by Kaplan et al suggests that 52% of children with dyslexia also have features of dyspraxia.
