This creates a new Git repo in the same directory as your solution and opens up the Publish view in Team Explorer so you can push your code to Azure Repos or another remote Git repository. In an empty folder. Open the Connect view in Team Explorer by choosing Projects then Manage Connections from the context menu. Under Local Git Repositories, select New and enter a folder where the repo will be created. This directory must be empty. Select Create to create the repo.

Using Visual Studio 2017 Community v15.6.6 A couple of versions back, I was able to create an empty WEBSITE project (NOT an web application -- I repeat -- an EMPTY WEBSITE project). The empty website project would typically contain a web.config file in the root directory and an EMPTY "Bin" folder.
