 Voice refers to the form of a verb that shows whether the subject of a sentence performs the action or is affected by it.
ACTIVE VOICE - Definition The form of a verb in which the subject is the person or thing that performs the action. Example: They finished the work. [subject -- "they", verb -- "finished", object -- "work"] In this sentence, the subject (they) acts on the object (work). Other Examples: The teacher

praises him. She posted the letter. I buy new books. We will celebrate his birthday.

PASSIVE VOICE - Definition The form of a verb in which the subject is affected by the action of the verb.
