Drosophila subobscura flies were collected from a poplar (*Populus alba*) wood in a swampy region located on the left bank of the river Danube, near the town of Apatin (45°40' N, 19°00' E, approximately 200 km NW of Belgrade). This region is included in the Ramsar List, which lists wetlands of international importance, and is known as the Upper Danube wetland area.
