ATP III Guidelines At-A-Glance Quick Desk Reference. Determine lipoprotein levels—obtain complete lipoprotein profile after 9- to 12-hour fast. ATP III Guidelines At-A-Glance Quick Desk Reference

Individuals 40 to 75 years of age with diabetes and LDL-C 70-189 mg/dL. For the primary prevention of ASCVD in individuals with diabetes (diabetes mellitus type-1 and type-2), estimated 10-year ASCVD risk can also be used to guide the intensity of statin therapy. Individuals without clinical ASCVD or diabetes who are 40 to 75 years of age with LDL-C 70- 189 mg/dL and an estimated 10-year ASCVD risk of 7.5% or higher.

ATP IV -ACC/AHA Latest cholesterol Guidelines - GlobalRPH

- All of the guidelines recommend treatment for patients with LDL-C ≥ 190 mg/dl.
- Of adults age 40 to 65 years, a comparative analysis estimated the ACC/AHA and ESC/EAS guidelines respectively recommend statin treatment in 43.8% versus 39.1%. the 4 statin benefit groups

- Maximally tolerated statin therapy is recommended for patients 20 to 75 years of age with an LDL-C level of 190 mg per dL or greater.

ATP II affirmed the importance of this approach and added a new feature: the intensive management of LDL cholesterol in persons with established CHD. For CHD patients, ATP II set a new, lower LDL cholesterol goal of ≤ 100 mg/dL.

High Blood Cholesterol Summary - NHLBI, NIH

For higher risk patients, ATP III allowed starting a drug at LDL-C > 100 mg/dL, whereas ACC/AHA starts statins at LDL-C > 70 mg/dL. The latter value is justified

The guideline suggests the race- and sex-specific Pooled Cohort Equation (PCE) (ASCVD Risk Estimator Plus) to estimate 10-year ASCVD risk for asymptomatic adults aged 40-79 years. Adults should be categorized into low ($< 5\%$), borderline (5 to $< 7.5\%$), intermediate (≥ 7.5 to $< 20\%$), or high ($\geq 20\%$) 10-year risk.

the primary target of therapy in previous lipid guidelines and in the practice of clinical lipidology, the NLA Expert Panel's consensus view is that non-HDL-C is a better primary target for modification than LDL-C. It is extremely important for everyone -- men and women of every age, with or without known heart disease — to have a low LDL cholesterol level. 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The goal for LDL-lowering therapy in high-risk patients is an LDL-C level 100 mg/dL. According to ATP III, for a baseline or on-treatment LDL-C 100 mg/dL, no further LDL-lowering therapy was recommended. For all high-risk patients with LDL-C levels 100 mg/dL, LDL-lowering dietary therapy should be initiated.
