Example of the Nonparametric Wilcoxon Test

1 sample Wilcoxon non parametric hypothesis test is a rank based test and it compares the standard value (theoretical value) with hypothesized median. Usually t-test depends on the sample mean which is not so stable in heavy tailed distribution; hence Wilcoxon test efficiency is high when compared to t-test.

Wilcoxon Signed-Ranks Test for Paired Samples When the requirements for the t-test for two paired samples are not satisfied, the Wilcoxon Signed-Rank Test for Paired Samples non-parametric test can often be used. Introduction. The Wilcoxon signed-rank test is the nonparametric test equivalent to the dependent t-test. As the Wilcoxon signed-rank test does not assume normality in the data, it can be used when this assumption has been violated and the use of the dependent t-test is inappropriate. It is used to compare two sets of scores that come from the same participants.

A Wilcoxon test is used when we have two interval or ratio level variables measured for a set of observations and we want to test if the distribution is different for the two variables but we are unable to assume normality for one or both of the variables. It can also be to compare ordered categorical variables.

Wilcoxon test in SPSS (Practical)

The Wilcoxon signed rank test relies on the W -statistic. For large samples with $n > 10$ paired observations the W -statistic approximates a normal distribution. The W statistic is a non-parametric test, thus it does not need multivariate normality in the data.

In statistics, the Mann-Whitney U test (also called the Mann-Whitney-Wilcoxon (MWW), Wilcoxon rank-sum test, or Wilcoxon-Mann-Whitney test) is a nonparametric test of the null hypothesis that, for randomly selected values X and Y from two populations, the probability of X being greater than Y is equal to the probability of Y being greater than X .
