'Ash Wednesday' constitutes the
greatest leap in Eliot's verse and life and
the greatest pause in his poetic writings
before the hiatus between his plays and
The Four Quartets. In 'Ash Wednesday,'
Eliot's poetic persona has somehow
found the courage, through spiritual
exhaustion, to seek faith. That faith

demands complete submission, including the admission that faith must ultimately come from without because what is within has been exhausted.

Poems for Lent (1): 'Ash Wednesday', TS Eliot

It helps to know that the main themes of Ash- Wednesday in the history of the church are those of repentance and renewal. From at least the fourth century the Western Church decided to set the Lenten season as 40 days before Easter. This is analogous to the 40 days of Christ's fasting in the desert (Matt. 4:2).
