For Example: Find a quadratic polynomial for the given numbers as the sum and product of its zeroes respectively 4, 1. Let the quadratic polynomial be $ax^2 + bx + c$. Given, $\alpha + \beta = 4 = 4/1 = -b/a$. $\alpha\beta = 1 = 1/1 = c/a$. Thus, $a = 1$, $b = -4$ and $c = 1$. Therefore, the quadratic polynomial is $x^2 - 4x + 1$.

A zero of a polynomial $p(x)$ is the value of x for which the value of $p(x)$ is 0. If k is a zero of $p(x)$, then $p(k)=0$. For example, consider a polynomial $p(x)=x^2 - 3x+2$. When $x=1$, the value of $p(x)$ will be equal to $p(1)=1^2-3 \times 1+2 =1-3+2 =0$. Since $p(x)=0$ at $x=1$, we say that 1 is a zero of the polynomial $x^2 - 3x+2$
