The lens closest to the specimen is called the objective lens, while the lens nearest to the user's eye is called

2) The compound light microscope magnifies the image of a specimen, when we try to measure the size of the specimen it is unrealistic to use units like millimeters or inches. A realistic measuring unit is micrometers. 1000 micrometers (μm) = 1 millimeter (mm) Micrometers are very small units of length.

The light microscope usually has three or four objective lenses on a microscope. They consist of 4x, 10x, 40x and 100x magnification powers. The objective lens focuses the light passing through the

specimen to form a magnified primary images. The eyepiece tube connect the eyepiece to the objective lens.
